Diocese News

Sunday, September 28, Bishop Joseph launched the Vision for Pastoral Renewal of the Diocese of Charlottetown. "We envision a future for our diocese where every parish and each Catholic is intentionally engaged in the mission of proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ. This future will be anchored by the seven pillars of a mission-oriented church: evangelization, discipleship, worship, community, service, stewardship, and leadership." The text of the vision for pastoral renewal and a letter from Bishop Joseph are now available on the Diocesan website.

March for Jesus PEI - On Saturday October 11th from 12 PM to 4 PM believers in Jesus from all backgrounds and denominations from across PEI are invited to gather in Charlottetown at Confederation Landing to join in a powerful and joyful public celebration of Jesus! Activities begin at 12 PM followed by the March for Jesus commencing at 1 PM from Confederation Landing. This Ecumenical Procession will wind its way through Charlottetown with police escort before returning to Confederation Landing at approximately 2 PM. There will be prayer, words of praise, witnessing and music before and after the March with the sole purpose of publicly proclaiming our Love for Jesus in celebration of faith, unity and hope! Marches for Jesus are held annually in a number of cities and towns throughout Canada.
