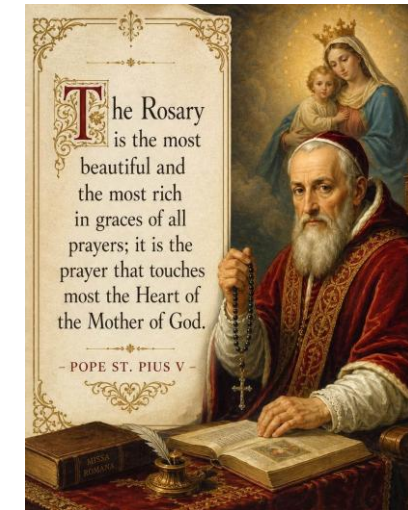
PRAYER FOR MOTHER'S DAY
