### PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear holy people of God. Peace be with you! St.  
Manuel, "The Bishop of the Abandoned  
Tabernacle" 'believed that the Person of Christ in  
the Eucharist had to be the source, the center,  
and the summit of the Church's evangelization  
and Catechesis. He experienced the primacy of the  
Eucharistic mystery very deeply in every aspect of  
his personal life.

He knew that as long as there were still generous  
souls willing to keep Christ company in Eucharistic  
Adoration, there was still great hope for the  
Church.

His Eucharistic piety— both his experience and  
his message— comprehensively encompasses the  
three dimensions of the Eucharistic Mystery: the  
Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the Sacramental gift of  
Holy Communion, and the Real Presence of the  
Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

He lived a taught from the fullness of these three  
dimensions, thus unleashing the fullness of grace  
which is available to us in the Eucharistic Mystery.  
His deepest desire was to spread Eucharistic  
Adoration and loving reverence for the  
abandoned tabernacle.

The degree to which a Tabernacle is abandoned is  
a sign of the degree to which a Parish is in a state  
of ill-health. Love for the Eucharistic Lord is the  
authentic gauge of a Christian community's faith  
and spiritual wellbeing' Pp31-32). Keep the faith  
and love in the Eucharist!! Dear friends in the  
Lord.
